Introduction

The Netherlands Advisory Board on Impact Investing ('NAB', 'we', 'us', or 'our') is committed to protecting your privacy and ensuring compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 ('GDPR') and the Dutch Telecommunications Act. This Cookie Policy explains how and why cookies and similar technologies are used on our website (www.nabimpactinvesting.nl), the types of cookies we use, and how you can manage your preferences. This policy should be read in conjunction with our Privacy Policy, which provides further detail on how we handle personal data.

What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device by websites you visit. They are widely used to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site. Cookies can be 'session' cookies (which are deleted when you close your browser) or 'persistent' cookies (which remain on your device until they expire, or you delete them). Cookies can also be used to collect information about your browsing behaviour for analytics or security purposes.

Why Do We Use Cookies?

We use cookies to:

- Ensure our website functions correctly and securely.
- Enhance user experience.

- Remember your preferences and settings.
- Conduct performance analysis and gather usage statistics.
- Understand how visitors interact with our website.
- Maintain security and prevent fraudulent activities.
- Ensure compliance with legal obligations.

We do not use cookies for advertising or profiling purposes.

Legal Basis for Using Cookies

Under GDPR, the use of cookies that are not strictly necessary requires a legal basis. We rely on your consent for the use of functional and analytical cookies. For strictly necessary cookies, our legal basis is legitimate interest in maintaining the functionality and security of our website.

Types of Cookies We Use

We use the following categories of cookies:

Cookie Type	Purpose	Examples
Strictly Necessary Cookies	Required for basic functionality and security.	XSRF-TOKEN, hs
Functional Cookies	Enable the website to remember user preferences.	svSession
Analytics Cookies	Collect anonymous data for performance analysis.	_ga, _gid, fedops.logger.defaultOverrides
Third-party Cookies	Set by external services to enable content or features.	YouTube embeds, Google Maps

Cookies Set by Wix

As our website is hosted on the Wix platform, cookies may be set by Wix to ensure the security and optimal performance of the platform. These cookies include:

- XSRF-TOKEN: Ensures visitor browsing security
- hs: Security cookie
- svSession: Identifies unique visitors and tracks sessions
- SSR-caching: Indicates how the site was rendered
- wixCIDX, _wix_browser_sess: For system monitoring/debugging

Consent Management

When you visit our site for the first time, you are presented with a cookie banner asking for your consent to use non-essential cookies. You can:

- Accept all cookies
- Reject non-essential cookies
- Customize preferences

Your choices will be stored for 12 months. You may change or withdraw your consent anytime via the footer link or browser settings.

Managing, Disabling and Deleting Cookies

You can configure your browser to refuse all or some cookies, or to alert you when websites set or access cookies. However, if you disable or refuse cookies, some parts of our website may become inaccessible or not function properly.

Third-Party Cookies and Services

Our website may include third-party content such as embedded videos or maps. These third parties may set their own cookies. We do not control these cookies. Please review the cookie policies of these third parties (e.g., YouTube, LinkedIn, Google Maps).

Data Retention

Cookie data is retained only for as long as necessary to fulfill its intended purpose. Analytical cookies are stored for a maximum of 14 months, unless consent is withdrawn earlier or longer retention is required by law.

Your Rights Under GDPR

As per Articles 6, 7, and 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), you have the right to:

- Be informed about how your data is collected and used
- Access your personal data
- Withdraw consent at any time
- Request deletion or rectification of data
- Complain with a supervisory authority

You are informed about the data collected, the purpose, and your rights through this policy.

Data collected via cookies is not used for profiling or automated decision-making.
